

**Improving Business Practices Training and Technical Assistance in Maryland's
Public Behavioral Health System**

Purpose of Survey:

The changing payment and service delivery landscape greatly alters how health care is delivered and paid for and with an expansion to service capacity, the Public Behavioral Health System (PBHS) wants to ensure that all behavioral health organizations are prepared.

In order to determine the PBHS provider training and technical assistance needs around practice improvements, new financing mechanisms, opportunities related to integration with primary care, and new service delivery models, a brief survey has been developed to collect responses directly from all behavioral health providers.

Behavioral health practitioners and organizations operating throughout Maryland including primary care, substance use related disorder and mental health providers in need of efficiency improvement interventions.
